Grant Requirements and Timeline

- <u>Partnership requirements:</u> Grants will prioritize robust equity-seeking partnership efforts that demonstrate streamlined and actionable collaboration to ensure equitable access to and support for students and families this summer.
 - Communities chosen must demonstrate partnerships focused on Pre-K through elementary age, high school age, or both. A school district must be an active partner, as well as an organization representing family voice.
 - Additionally, a combination of public and private/non-profit partnerships may include early childhood, out-of-school time providers, labor and workforce, higher education, family resource centers, mental health providers, municipal programs, and others.
 - Partners must be willing and able to execute expanded or new summer programming/services that are designed to address COVID-related family and whole child/youth needs, in addition to academics.
 - While the funding timeline may mean that completely new offerings are unlikely, the application should demonstrate what a new or strengthened partnership will allow for this summer (and beyond) that would not have happened otherwise.
- <u>Application requirements:</u> applications must address the components below via a combination of written proposal and video (video optional). Application, video, and budget guidance follow.
- If selected, you will be notified no later than May 28, 2021.
- Grants will run from June 1 September 1 with focus on targeted student and family engagement and support this summer.
